## Presentation Overview

### Stormwater Harvesting Scheme

Increasingly developers are coming under pressure to demonstrate that their projects minimise the increase in demand on potable mains water supplies and manage increases in storm flows and runoff quality. After careful consideration of the options available to achieve these objectives, the proponents of the Riverstone Crossing development at Upper Coomera opted for a stormwater harvesting and reuse scheme. This presentation examines the selection process and the conceptual design methods used by Gilbert & Sutherland to size the major system components including the 'Rainvault' – the 2008 winner of the SIA's Award for Excellence for 'Stormwater Harvesting and Reuse'.
