Presentation Overview

In the last few years, there have been major changes in the urban water and catchment management 'playing' field in South East Queensland. This presentation will attempt to outline the nature and drivers of these changes and to map their potential benefits and impacts at a range of relevant spatial and temporal scales. Where possible, these benefits and impacts will be quantified with real world, worked examples. A summary and review of how the author believes we should be moving forward in order to capitalise on these changes, and an appraisal of the potential barriers which are presenting themselves in this regard, will also be provided for discussion and debate.
