Looking ahead to 2009/10: A Water by Design Perspective

South East Queensland is widely regarded as leading the way in the adoption of water sensitive urban design (WSUD), although the sector as a whole is still considered to be performing well below its potential. To ensure the implementation of best practice WSUD, there is a strong need for capacity building so that practitioners have sound design and analysis tools, thus enabling WSUD to become an integral feature of urban development and redevelopment projects.

In this presentation, Alan Hoban from Water by Design, will provide an overview of what's planned for this sector in 2009/10. What will constitute best practice? What should the industry expect and what will be expected of the industry? This will include an overview of key policy reforms, tools and resources.

Alan Hoban holds a Bachelor of Environmental Engineering and Science, majoring in physical geography. He is the recipient of several awards and has worked as an advisor and speechwriter for the Thai Government on climate change and water resource projects. In 2001, Alan managed the Victorian Cool Communities energy efficiency program. He is a founder of Flexicar.com.au, which operates a network of over 60 web-enabled, self service vehicles in partnership with local governments in Sydney and Melbourne. Alan has extensive experience in water sensitive urban design. He is currently the manager of Water by Design capacity building program for the Healthy Waterways Partnership and chairs the WSUD component of the Urban Stormwater Quality Working Group.
