Presentation Overview

The Australian Government invites us to innovate in order to create Water Sensitive Australian Cities in response to our current urban water challenges. But what is a water sensitive city and how do we make the transition? In early 2009 a group of young professionals from Australia's water industry travelled to the United Kingdom, Germany, Spain, the Netherlands and Singapore to find out. The group engaged with leading thinkers on urban sustainability, explored the communities in these cities, and viewed the transitions that have been achieved. This session will reflect on the common themes and drivers from the tour, including building resilience to climate change, integration of water with the urban form and energy, marketing and education, knowledge transfer, and people and partnerships.
